



HOUSESTEADS ROMAN FORT

Housesteads Roman Fort in Northumberland is set halfway along Hadrian's Wall and is the most complete example of a Roman fort in Britain. It was built around AD 122 (when work on Hadrian's Wall began) and was home to an 800-strong infantry regiment until the end of the fourth century. 
