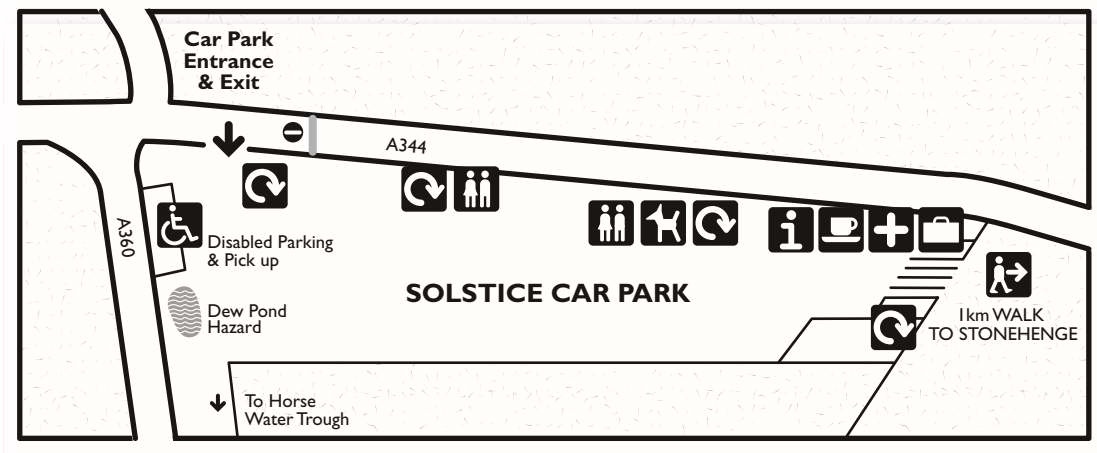
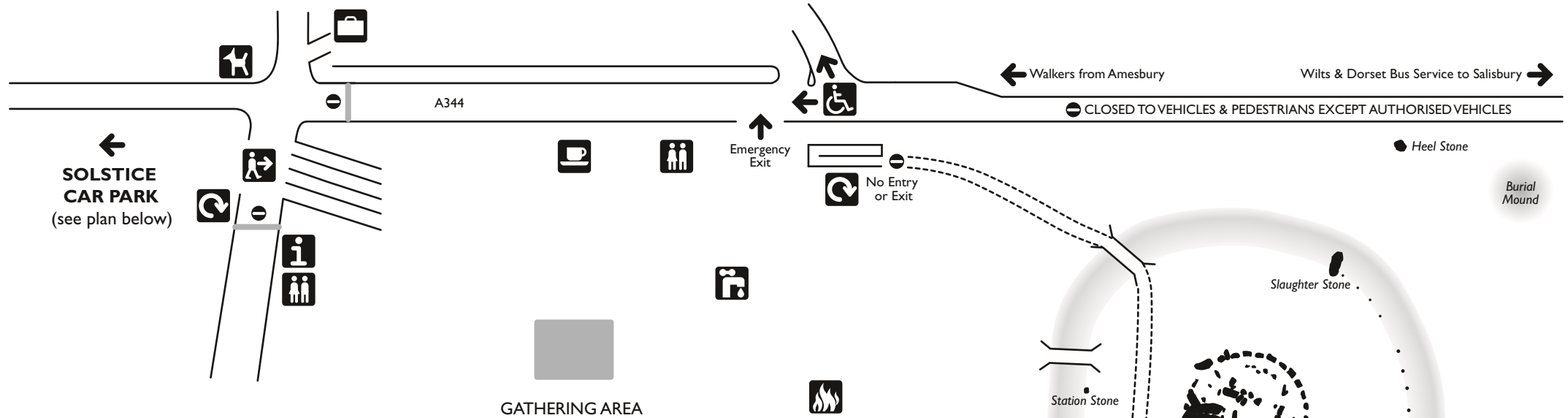


# SUMMER SOLSTICE MAP

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

We would like to wish you a happy and enjoyable Solstice

### Timings

Solstice Car Park Opens	1900 hrs (7pm)	20 <sup>th</sup> June
Access to Stonehenge Starts	1900 hrs (7pm)	20 <sup>th</sup> June
Last Access to Solstice Car Park	0600 hrs (6am)	21 <sup>st</sup> June
Stonehenge Closes	0800 hrs (8am)	21 <sup>st</sup> June
Solstice Car Park to be Vacated	1200 hrs (12 noon)	21 <sup>st</sup> June



### Respect

Stonehenge is seen by many as a sacred site - please respect it and each other. Drunken, disorderly or anti social behaviour will not be tolerated.



### Animals

Dogs, pets and other creatures are not permitted into Stonehenge, except registered assistance dogs.



### The Stones

In the interests of personal safety and protecting this special site, please do not climb or stand on the stones.



### Bags

Only small bags/rucksacks (similar size to hand luggage on airlines) will be permitted into Stonehenge.



### Alcohol

Only small amounts of alcohol for personal use will be permitted.



### Fire

The nature of this access makes any real flames extremely dangerous. Please do not bring or light fires, flaming torches, candles or fireworks.



### Glass

As some people walk barefoot and livestock also graze in the area, glass items may not be brought into Stonehenge.



### No Camping

Camping is not permitted at Stonehenge, in the Solstice Car Park or anywhere in the surrounding National Trust land.



### Under 16's

Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an Adult.



### Lighting

In the interests of public safety there will be ambient lighting throughout the night. Lights will be systematically turned off as dawn approaches.
