

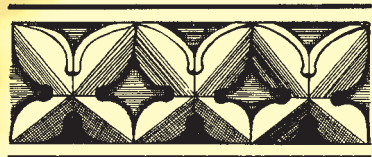


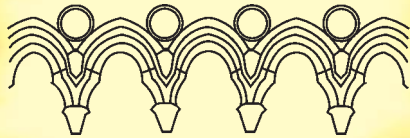
I lived, worked

Pillars

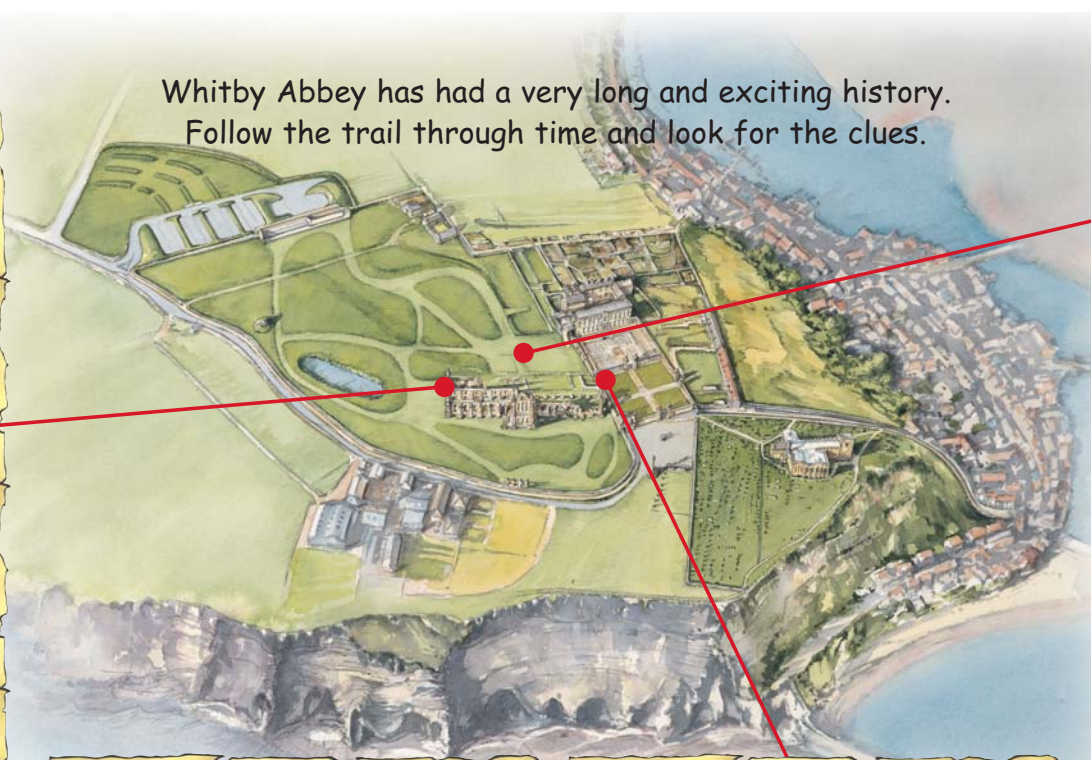
The abbey church had lots of big stone pillars to hold up the roof, with 4 huge pillars to hold up the tower.

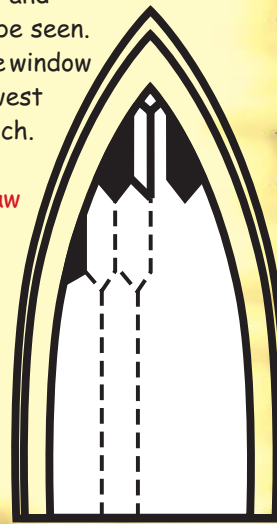
Arches and Windows
