Smell the gentle fragrance of rose gardens, wisteria and rhododendrons



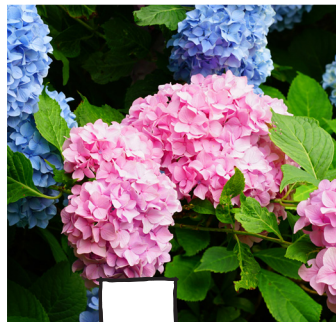
Go exploring and search out the historic graffiti and marks left by visitors and others over the centuries
