◆ **Opening Times valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:**

1 Apr – 31 Oct 10am – 5pm Wed – Sun & Bank Hol Mon (Last admission is 4pm)
1 Nov – 31 Mar Closed

◆ **Site Location:** 8 miles north west of Wolverhampton on an unclassified road. East of the A41 and 1 mile south of the A5.

◆ **Coach Parking:** There is space for 5 coaches to park on site, free of charge.

◆ **Prices & Group Discounts valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:** We offer a 15% discount for groups of 11 or more paying visitors, if one person makes payment for the group. You also receive one free place for every additional 20 people in your group, plus free entry for the tour leader and coach driver. English Heritage members are admitted free of charge and do not count towards the group numbers.

House & Grounds: Normal admission price: £5.20 per adult; £4.40 per concession; £2.60 per child.

House & Grounds: Group of 11 or more paying visitors: £4.42 per adult; £3.74 per concession; £2.21 per child.

Carers for visitors with disabilities FREE. English Heritage Members FREE.

Prices may vary on event days, please reconfirm with the site.

◆ **Guided Tours:** Tours run throughout the day about every 45 minutes. The tour lasts for about 30 minutes and is included in the admission price. There is a maximum of 25 people per tour.

◆ **Guide Books:** Available at a cost of £2.99. Pre-order to ensure that your guidebooks are ready and pre-packed for your arrival.

◆ **Duration of Visit:** We advise you to allow at least 2 hours for your visit.

◆ **Disabled Access:** Parking is adjacent to the shop and there is a compacted gravel surface. Access to the site is via the shop or side gate, there is a cobbled farmyard surface so assistance is required. There is no wheelchair access to the house and assistance is needed to access the exhibition. Access to the gardens is via paths. There is no accessible toilet on site but the shop is accessible. Please make us aware of the special needs of any member of your group before your arrival so that we can offer every assistance.

◆ **Catering:** Picnics are welcome in the grounds.

◆ **Facilities:** Shop and exhibition which are accessible. Toilets are on site but they are not accessible.

◆ **Restrictions:** Dogs are allowed on site if on a lead and in the grounds only. No Smoking is allowed on site.
