◆ **Opening Times valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:**

1 Apr – 30 Jun	10am – 5pm	Daily
1 Jul – 31 Aug	10am – 6pm	Daily

1 Oct – 1 Nov	10am – 4pm	Daily
2 Nov – 31 Mar	Closed	

◆ **Site Location:** Located in Washford, ¼ mile south of A39.

◆ **Coach Parking:** There is free parking for 2 coaches on site.

◆ **Prices & Group Discounts valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:** We offer a 15% discount for groups of 11 or more paying visitors, if one person makes payment for the group. You also receive one free place for every additional 20 people in your group, plus free entry for the tour leader and coach driver. English Heritage members are admitted free of charge and do not count towards the group numbers.

Normal admission price: £3.80 per adult; £3.20 per concession; £1.90 per child.

Group of 11 or more paying visitors: £3.23 per adult; £2.72 per concession; £1.62 per child.

Carers for visitors with disabilities FREE. English Heritage Members FREE.

Prices may vary on event days, please reconfirm with the site.

◆ **Guided Tours:** A guided tour of the site costs normal admission plus £1.00 per person. Please note there is a minimum group size of 25 for this tour and tours must be booked at least 4 weeks in advance.

◆ **Guide Books:** Available in English at a cost of £2.99. Pre-order to ensure that your guidebooks are ready and pre-packed for your arrival.

◆ **Duration of Visit:** We advise you to allow at least 45 minutes for your visit.

◆ **Disabled Access:** Disabled parking is through the gatehouse entrance and about 20 metres from the admission point. Most of the ground floor of the abbey is accessible either via 4 steps (in the exhibition area) or via an alternative route. There is ramp access from the grounds to the church and cloisters. There is gravel and cobbles in the courtyard. The upper floor is reached via a staircase, often accessible to ambulant disabled visitors with assistance. All staircases have solid handrails and there is a wheelchair available on request. All areas of the grounds are accessible via short mown grass, cobblestone and compacted gravel. The exhibition has easy access to its first room via the shop and the 2 further rooms are accessed via 4 steep steps. The exhibition includes a touch-screen virtual tour which is ideal for visitors who will not be able to easily get around the site. The toilets are on site and are accessible as is the shop. Please make us aware of the special needs of any member of your group before your arrival so that we can offer every assistance.

◆ **Catering:** Hot drinks, soft drinks, snacks and ice creams can be purchased on site. Picnics are welcome in the grounds.

◆ **Facilities:** shop and toilets on site and both are wheelchair accessible. There is an exhibition on site which is accessible and has a touch-screen virtual tour of the site.
