Group Visits Information

◆ **Opening Times valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:**

1 Apr – 30 Jun	10am – 5pm	Daily
1 Jul – 31 Aug	10am – 6pm	Daily
1 – 30 Sep	10am – 5pm	Daily
1 Oct – 1 Nov	10am – 4pm	Daily
2 Nov – 31 Mar	10am – 4pm	Sat – Sun
24 – 26 Dec & 1 Jan	Closed	

◆ **Site Location:** The castle is off the A30 2 miles south west of Tisbury. The site is also accessible from the A350.

◆ **Coach Parking:** Although the site entrance is accessible for coaches the approach road is very narrow so it may be necessary to alight at the end of the road and walk the ¼ mile to the site entrance. Please phone the site to confirm accessibility especially during the winter months (Nov – Mar) as adverse weather conditions may force the site to close.

◆ **Prices & Group Discounts valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:** We offer a 15% discount for groups of 11 or more paying visitors, if one person makes payment for the group. You also receive one free place for every additional 20 people in your group, plus free entry for the tour leader and coach driver. English Heritage members are admitted free of charge and do not count towards the group numbers.

Normal admission price: £3.60 per adult; £3.10 per concession; £1.80 per child.

Group of 11 or more paying visitors: £3.06 per adult; £2.64 per concession; £1.53 per child.

Carers for visitors with disabilities FREE. English Heritage Members FREE.

Prices may vary on event days, please reconfirm with the site.

◆ **Guided Tours:** There is a guided tour of the site, free of charge but the tour must be booked at least 4 weeks in advance. Audio guides are also available free of charge but are subject to availability.

◆ **Guide Books:** Available in English at a cost of £2.99. Pre-order to ensure that your guidebooks are ready and pre-packed for your arrival.

◆ **Duration of Visit:** We advise you to allow at least 1 ½ – 2 hours for your visit.

◆ **Disabled Access:** Parking is 8.5 metres from the entrance via smooth tarmac. Access to the castle is via compacted gravel and a grass path. There are 6 steps at the entrance and there is a ramped entrance on the rear of the castle which only allows access to the ground floor (assistance is recommended). The grounds are accessible via loose gravel paths and smooth grass (soft in the winter). There are 4 steps to the pavilion and benches are provided in the summer. For visually impaired visitors there are carvings which can be touched. There is an accessible toilet at the kiosk but you need to ask a member of staff for the key. Please make us aware of the special needs of any member of your group before your arrival so that we can offer every assistance.

◆ **Catering:** Hot drinks, soft drinks and snack can be purchased on site. Picnics are welcome in the grounds.

◆ **Facilities:** Small shop (in kiosk).
