◆ **Opening Times valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:**

1 Apr – 30 Sep	10am – 5pm	Daily
1 Oct – 1 Nov	10am – 4pm	Daily
2 Nov – 31 Mar	10am – 4pm	Sat – Mon
24 – 26 Dec & 1 Jan	Closed	

◆ **Site Location:** In Warkworth village 7 ½ miles south of Alnwick, on the A1068.

◆ **Coach Parking:** There are 2 free spaces can be made available but they have to be pre-booked. There is a coach park ¼ mile from the castle through the village and up the beach road.

◆ **Prices & Group Discounts valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:** We offer a 15% discount for groups of 11 or more paying visitors, if one person makes payment for the group. You also receive one free place for every additional 20 people in your group, plus free entry for the tour leader and coach driver. English Heritage members are admitted free of charge and do not count towards the group numbers.

Normal admission price: £ 4.20 per adult; £3.60 per concession; £2.10 per child
Group of 11 or more paying visitors £3.57 per adult; £3.06 per concession; £1.79 per child
Carers for visitors with disabilities FREE. English Heritage Members FREE.
Prices may vary on event days, please reconfirm with the site.

◆ **Guided Tours:** We have a limited amount of free audio tour handsets which have to be booked a week in advance. The tour lasts about 35 minutes.

◆ **Guide Books:** Available in English at a cost of £3.50. Pre-order to ensure that your guidebooks are ready for your arrival.

◆ **Duration of Visit:** We advise you to allow 35 minutes to 1 hour.

◆ **Disabled Access:** Parking 30m from entrance via gravel, grass, bridge slats and ramp of compacted gravel into grounds. Ramped access into shop. Access into castle grounds mostly on compacted gravel and grass surface. Keep only accessible up wide staircase. Inside keep main staircase has handrail. Toilets: Adapted W.C. in car park. Audio Tours for visually impaired, hearing impaired and visitors with learning difficulties are available but like all audios have to be booked in advance. Please make us aware of the special needs of any member of your group before your arrival so that we can offer every assistance.

◆ **Facilities:** Shop and toilets are both on site. Picnics are welcome in the grounds.

◆ **Restrictions:** Dogs on leads are allowed on site if on a lead in the grounds only. **No Commercial Photography** is allowed on site.
