◆ **Opening Times valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:**

1 Apr – 1 Nov	10am – 5pm	Daily
2 Nov – 28 Feb	10am – 4pm	Wed – Sun
1 – 31 Mar	10am – 5pm	Daily
24 – 26 Dec & 1 Jan	Closed	

◆ **Site Location:** 5 miles east of Shrewsbury on the B4380.

◆ **Coach Parking:** There is free coach parking on site.

◆ **Prices & Group Discounts valid from 1 April 2009 to 31 March 2010:** We offer a 15% discount for groups of 11 or more paying visitors, if one person makes payment for the group. You also receive one free place for every additional 20 people in your group, plus free entry for the tour leader and coach driver. English Heritage members are admitted free of charge and do not count towards the group numbers.

Normal admission price: £4.20 per adult; £3.60 per concession; £2.10 per child.

Group of 11 or more paying visitors: £3.57 per adult; £3.06 per concession; £1.79 per child.

Carers for visitors with disabilities FREE. English Heritage Members FREE.

Prices may vary on event days, please reconfirm with the site.

◆ **Guided Tours:** Audio guides are available free of charge but are subject to availability.

◆ **Guide Books:** Available at a cost of £3.99. Pre-order to ensure that your guidebooks are ready and pre-packed for your arrival.

◆ **Duration of Visit:** We advise you to allow at least 1 ¾ hours for your visit.

◆ **Disabled Access:** Parking is about 8 metres from the entrance with an uneven surface; there is a setting down point at the entrance gate. There is ramped access to the visitor centre. The site is mostly accessible, except some areas within walls, via smooth grass, cobbles, and loose and compacted gravel paths. There are some slopes and bumpy areas. Manual wheelchair users are advised to bring an assistant. The secondary viewing platform has level access. The audio guide has a hearing loop for the hard of hearing. There is an accessible toilet within the visitor centre and the shop and museum both have level access. Please make us aware of the special needs of any member of your group before your arrival so that we can offer every assistance.

◆ **Catering:** Hot drinks and soft drinks are available in the shop. Picnics are welcome in the grounds.

◆ **Facilities:** Shop, toilets and museum all accessible.

◆ **Restrictions:** Dogs are allowed on site only if on a lead and in the grounds only. **No Smoking** is allowed on site.
