

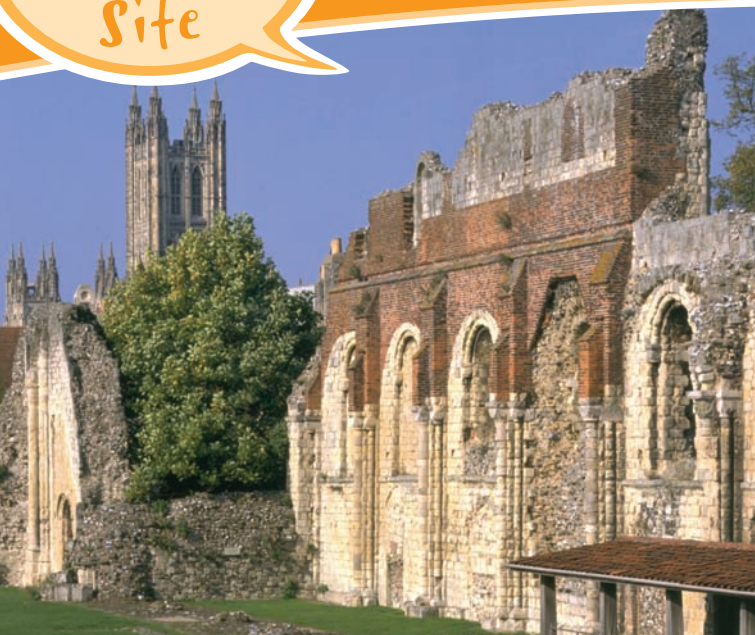

# St Augustine's Abbey

This great abbey was founded by St. Augustine in AD597 during his mission to convert the pagan Anglo-Saxons to Christianity. The first Christian burial place for English kings, it is steeped in history and atmosphere.



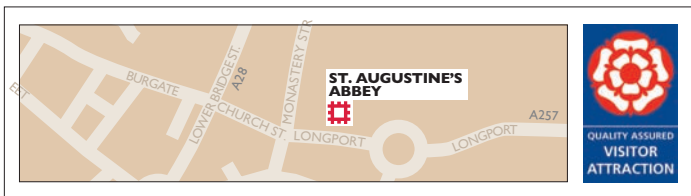
