

ENGLISH HERITAGE ALSF PROGRAMME : PARTNERSHIP FUNDING

The English Heritage ALSF Programme does not require partnership funding as a condition of grant and can fund 100 per-cent of project costs. However, we particularly welcome applications which bring partnership funding or some other resource contribution and so lever-in additional resources for the historic environment.

RESTRICTIONS

There are no restrictions on the sources of partnership funding with the following exceptions:

Landfill Tax Credit Scheme (<http://www.ltcs.org.uk>)

English Heritage is enrolled as an Environmental Body and is therefore precluded from any form of third-party funding for Landfill Tax Credit purposes.

Other English Heritage Grant Schemes

ALSF projects must be additional to activity funded through other English Heritage grant schemes: joint funding from other English Heritage grants schemes is therefore ruled out.

EUROPEAN UNION FUNDING PROGRAMMES

There is nothing in ALSF rules to prevent match funding from EU funding programmes. However, we recommended that applicants considering this should check the rules of individual funding programmes.
