



## Landmark Hospitality at WELLINGTON ARCH

ORIGINALLY DESIGNED in 1825 by the architect Decimus Burton, Wellington Arch was intended as both a victory arch marking Wellington's defeat of Napoleon and as a grand outer entrance to Buckingham Palace.

Few people realise this famous landmark located in the centre of Hyde Park Corner conceals one of London's most fashionable and unique party venues within its magnificent arched walls. Crowned by the largest bronze statue in the UK, entitled with grandeur "Peace Descending on the Quadriga of War", it's a venue sure to impress.
