

## Directions

### Car

- From the M27(A27) take the A2030 turn-off for Southsea (1).
- Stay on the A2030 until you reach a small roundabout.
- Turn left at the roundabout onto Milton Road (2).
- Go straight ahead at the first set of traffic lights (University of Portsmouth on the left).
- At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto Bransbury Road (3).
- Take the first left onto Fort Cumberland Road (4).
- The entrance to Fort Cumberland is opposite Southsea Marina on the right.
- The vehicle & pedestrian gate has an intercom. Please press button and report your arrival.
- Follow the road round and report to Reception, whereupon your host will be informed of your arrival.

### Train

Nearest train station is Fratton.

### Walking (from Fratton train station)

Fort Cumberland is approximately 45 minutes from the station.

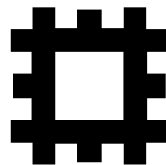
- Cross the footbridge and turn left onto Goldsmith Avenue (A2030).
- At the end of Goldsmith Avenue turn right at the traffic lights onto Eastney Road.
- Go straight ahead at the first set of traffic lights (University of Portsmouth on the left).
- At the next set of traffic lights turn left onto Bransbury Road.
- Follow Bransbury Road past the park on the left.
- Take the first left onto Fort Cumberland Road.
- Follow Fort Cumberland Road until you reach Southsea Marina on the left.
- The entrance to Fort Cumberland is opposite the Marina on the right.
- The vehicle & pedestrian gate has an intercom. Please press button and report your arrival.
- Follow the path through the arched entrance, then the road straight ahead and report to Reception.

### Bus (from Fratton train station)

The No.57 bus is the only service that runs near Fratton station (from Fratton Road) and goes to Fort Cumberland approximately every 30 minutes.

### Taxi (from Fratton train station)

Fort Cumberland is a 5-10 minute drive from the station - there are usually plenty of taxis waiting (costing c £4).

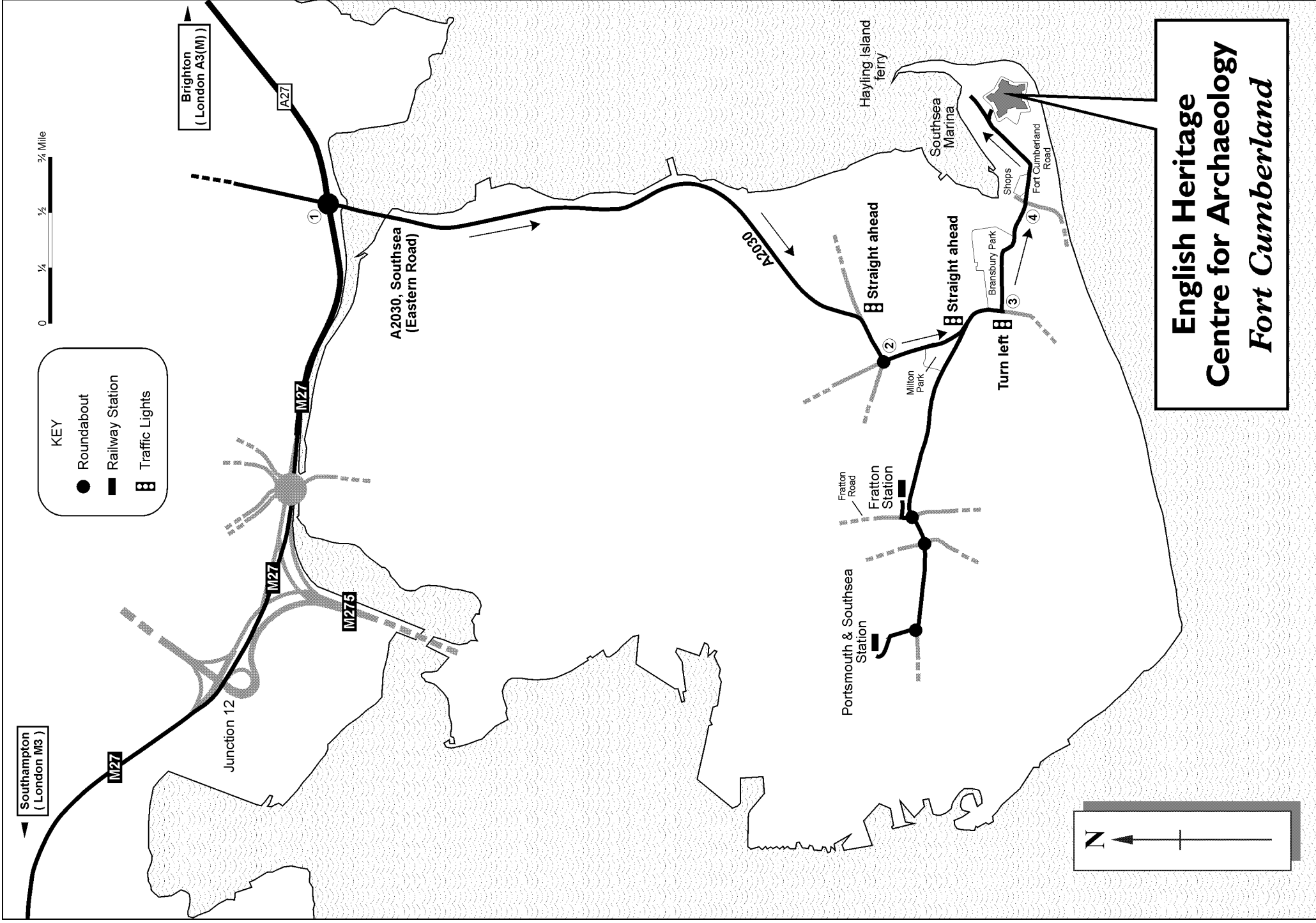
