## NMR ARCHIVES: EASTBOURNE ORIGINALS

### About the catalogue

This volume is arranged alphabetically by county, district and civil parish or non-parished area. Where no county identification has been possible entries appear at the beginning of the catalogue.

For each administrative area the buildings, monuments or more general subjects (eg street scenes or landscapes) represented in the archive are presented as follows: unattributed general views (blank caption) and *unidentified* buildings followed by an alphabetical listing of named and addressed buildings and monuments. Street scenes are found under the name of the street.

The names of structures comprising a complex of buildings are expressed in a hierarchy, with the principal or generic name first. For example, the Royal Mausoleum at Frogmore House would appear as:

FROGMORE HOUSE, ROYAL MAUSOLEUM

Similarly, tombs or monuments within churches or cathedrals would appear after the name of the building:

ST PAULS CATHEDRAL, WELLINGTON TOMB

## NMR ARCHIVES: EASTBOURNE ORIGINALS

### Eastbourne Originals

The Eastbourne Originals collection is a small set of original photographic prints of buildings and landscape scenes in or near Eastbourne, East Sussex.

### The History of the Collection

NMR Curation and Conservation Section purchased the collection from the Sidney Antiques Centre Market, Canterbury on 12<sup>th</sup> March 1994. It was catalogued in detail by the External Accessions Cataloguing Team on 16<sup>th</sup> May 2001.

### Description of the Collection

The collection consists of 10 original black and white photographic prints ranging in size from 5.5 x 4" to 12 x 8.75". Four are mounted prints, the remaining six are unmounted. Only one print is dated, to 1863, but others are datable from the subject matter, which includes construction of a new road through the Downs in c.1885 and of Beachy Head Lighthouse in 1902. Remaining views include a bank, hotel, fire station as well as street scenes and landscapes, and these have been approximately dated to between 1870 and 1890.

Two of the photographs were taken by the local photographic firm of G and R Lavis, but others may have been taken by them.

### Consulting the Collection

The collection may be viewed at the NMRC **by appointment**. Permission to copy or reproduce images should be sought from the National Monuments Record (NMR) which administers the copyright for the collection.
