## Living History Encampment (LHE)

Throughout the day take part in a school of defence with weapon masters showing their pupils how to use their weapons including German longsword and messer (Tal Hoffer) and Burgundian (Jue del la hache) poleaxe and see reproduction manuals from the 15<sup>th</sup> century.
