Medieval Season at Framlingham Castle

Saturday 20 July – Sunday I September I Oam – 5pm

Join us at Framlingham Castle during the summer holidays to learn what life was like in medieval times. From calligraphy to medieval archaeology, and rulers to peasants there will be different activities each week for children to take part in.

This Week:

It is the 15th Century and the Wars of the Roses rage. Test your sword skills ready for battle. Could you fight from horse back? Use our hobby horses and lances to test your skill at the targets! Prepare for battle at midday as we tell the story of the Battle of Bosworth.

10:30	Sword School	Practice your sword fighting with quintains and dummies – you never know when an attack may begin
11:30	Jousting	Don a helmet, mount your hobby horse, and pick up a lance to learn how to joust!
12:30	Sword School	Last chance to master the sword before the battle!
13:30	The Battle!	The battle is nigh! Get in formation as we retell the story of what happened at the Battle of Bosworth
14:30	Jousting	Take turns to gallop towards your target upon your hobby horse with lance in hand
15:30	Sword School	Last chance to perfect your swordplay with UP AN' AT 'EM! HISTORY

Available throughout the day: Medieval Armour Tent

Handle some weapons and kit of a 15th-century soldier and find out what it was like in the Wars of the Roses!

All children must be supervised by an adult when taking part in these activities.
