

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Eligibility and how to redeem the Offer

For the duration of the Twixmas period, from 26 December 2019 to 1 January 2020, English Heritage is running a promotion on Twitter where users can retweet our tweet for a chance to win a range of promotional offers.

- This promotion is open to all residents and visitors to aged 18 years or over.
- 2 The promotion runs on Twitter from 19 December 2019 to 1 January 2020 but winning promotional prizes can only be redeemed during normal site opening hours between 26 December 2019 and 1 January 2020.
- 3 The winning promotional offers can be redeemed at all English Heritage sites open during this period. See website for details **www.english-hertitage.org.uk/christmas/christmas-opening-times**
- 4 The promotional offers are not valid for redemption at any events outside of normal opening hours.
- 5 Only one winning promotional offer can be redeemed per person.
- 6 How to redeem your winning promotional offers:
 - All winners will need to show confirmation of their promotional prize offer on admission to the site or when purchasing a retail item (a tweet sent from **@EnglishHeritage**).
 - On claiming your winning promotional prize you may also be asked to show your loggedin account within the Twitter app by tapping on their profile picture top left and then 'Profile'.
 - If you have won a free family ticket offer, this entitles the person holding the logged-in account on which they have received their promotional offer to one complimentary family ticket admission (2 adults and up to 3 children) at one of the participating paid-for-entry sites.
 - English Heritage Members winning a free family ticket, may bring with them for free up to 2 nonmember adults and 3 non-member children on production of their membership card in the name of the person holding the logged – in account on which they have received their promotional offer.
 - If you have won a 2 for I offer, this entitles the person holding the logged-in account on which they have received their promotional offer to one free admission at one of the participating paid-forentry sites when an adult admission of equal or greater value is purchased. The cheapest ticket is free Maximum of one free ticket per person. An adult is classified as a person 18 years and over.
 - English Heritage Members receiving the 2 for 1 offer, may bring along one non-member guest for free on production of their membership card in the name of the person holding the logged in account on which they have received their promotional offer.
 - Retail offers are valid on all retail purchases made between 26 December 2019 and 1 January 2020 from the retail ranges available at the site where the offer will be redeemed, excluding sale lines and stamps (site branded and Royal Mail).
 - The offer cannot be redeemed on any online purchases.

Restrictions

- 7 The promotional prize offer cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer or concession including guided tours, annual membership, overseas visitor passes, paid for entry evening events and any other discount vouchers.
