

ACCESS INFORMATION

Seating and rest points are located around the hall and grounds. There is a golf buggy available on site to aid the mobility impaired. Pathways are mainly tarmac, some are gravel and all are flat. If you need further information or medical assistance please ask a member of staff.

- Stairs from ground floor to first floor of Main Hall, and from there down to first floor of Servants' Wing. Stone stairs from first floor of Servants' Wing to ground floor; some of the treads are smooth and worn.
- Pushchairs allowed Prams, pushchairs and back carriers for babies are not allowed in the fragile interiors of the Hall.
- There are five disabled parking spaces directly outside the hall If these are full, there is a golf buggy service available from the main car park. Parking or set down outside the hall is only allowed on non-event days.
- Hall The ground floor is level with lift access to the first floor.
