10.00am	Living History Encampments open
10.30am	Welcome music from GreenMatthews Toe tapping tunes with a nautical flavor.
11.00am	Cutlasses & Cudgels A small group of 'locals' are sorting through some wreckage that has been 'washed up' on the beach. Some other sailors arrive and question the fairness of the distribution of the salvaged goods. The discussion gets heated and it soon comes to blows with whatever lays to hand. (On the Bowling Green)
11.30am	Know your Enemy! Join our resident historian and the local squire, Sir Henry Goodfellow, in the Pirate Encampment as they give a briefing in how to spot a Golden Age Pirate. (On the Bowling Green)
12.00pm	Songs of the Sea Join GreenMatthews for some deep-blue-water ditties and rousing sea shanties. (On the Bowling Green)
12.30pm	Mutiny on the Bounty Join Wizzo's Rip Roaring History for the incredible true story of a desperate crew and their treacherous act of mutiny against their captain in the age of sail! (On the Bowling Green)
1.00pm	Maggot Tom's sharp (half) wit Watch Tom prance pun and parry whilst protecting the plunderwithout any prior practice. (On the Governess Lawn)
1.30pm	Firepower! Join Squire Goodfellow and Captain Staffage for a look at the weapons used by sailors and soldiers of the Golden Age of Piracy. From pistols and muskets, to ship busting ordnance, there will be fire, smoke and the boom of black powder. (On the Bowling Green)
2.00pm	Songs of Pirates and Rogues Join GreenMatthews for ballads of pirates, robbers and other ne'er-do-wells OR Napple on the numbskul - Maggot Tom missed canon training. Not to be trusted with gunpowder watch tom fire the deadlyapple! Stilts, flying apples, fire what could possibly go wrong! (On the Governess Lawn)

3.00pm	Maggot Tom in the brig! He's drunk the captain's rum And now he's clapped in irons. Can he escape? Can he change his fate? Well it's not for the want of try'n. (On the Governess Lawn)
3.30pm	Sea, Smugglers & Swords! Sir Henry and some local sailors are helping to clear the shore of wreckage, but all is not well. Captain Staffage dispatches the local militia to investigate suspicious activity and a simple misunderstanding spirals
