

## WALMER CASTLE AND GARDENS ART COMPETITION Terms and Conditions

- 1. This Competition is open to all Key Stage 4 and 5 art students, excluding anyone professionally connected with this Competition.
- 2. The Competition opens at 9am on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 and closes at midnight on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2020 ('Closing Date').
- 3. Entrants must register their interest in taking part with Rachel Hudson, Education Visits Officer on 01304 209878 or by email <u>rachel.hudson@english-heritage.org.uk</u>.
- 4. A condition of entry is that entrants must visit Walmer Castle, which they can do for free with their school on a self-led visit. Teachers must book directly through our Education booking team by calling 0370 333 0606 or emailing <u>bookeducation@english-heritage.org.uk</u>.
- 5. The Winner will receive  $\pounds 100$  of art supplies and the Winner's school will also receive  $\pounds 100$  of art supplies. The winning pupil and the winning school may select the items that they would like up to a value of  $\pounds 100$  and English Heritage will purchase them on their behalf. The two runner-up prize winners will receive  $\pounds 50$  of art supplies that they will select and English Heritage will purchase on their behalf.
- 6. To enter the Competition, entrants must upload a photograph of their Competition entry to our dropbox account (details will be provided) by the Closing Date.
- 7. The Winners will be selected by a panel of judges and be notified by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020.
- 8. If the Winner cannot be contacted within 5 days of notification, English Heritage reserves the right to offer the prize to other entrants selected from the entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 9. The decision of the judge is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 10. Entrants' artwork may be displayed at the Blooming Gardens event in June 2020.
- 11. By entering this Competition, the Entrant's parent or legal guardian is consenting to the use of the Entrant's name and image for publicity purposes on social media channels, websites and in any other media and agree to accompany the Entrant to any publicity events related to the Competition. The parent or legal guardian of shortlisted Entrants will be required to complete a Consent Form.
- 12. By entering this Competition, the School is consenting to the use of the School's name and image for publicity purposes on social media channels, websites and in any other media and agrees that a member of staff accompanies the Entrant to any publicity events related to the Competition.
- 13. Only one entry shall be accepted per student.



- 14. No entry fee or purchase is necessary to enter the Competition.
- 15. Any entry which is illegible or unintelligible may be disqualified in the sole discretion of English Heritage and English Heritage is not responsible for entries that are damaged, delayed, or lost in transit. Proof of sending is not proof of delivery.
- 16. There is no alternative prize and the prize may not be transferred to another person.
- 17. Entry in the Competition signifies acceptance of these rules. English Heritage reserves the right to withhold or cancel the prize in the event of non-compliance with these rules. English Heritage also reserves the right at its discretion to change the prize and/or amend the Competition rules at any time.
- 18. All personal data provided to English Heritage will be held and processed in accordance with the requirements of the 1998 Data Protection Act. We will keep your personal data safe and secure. We will not share it with other organisations without your knowledge and consent, unless required by law to do so.
