



HENRY II'S CROWN ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS










ST EDWARD'S CROWN ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Print and cut out the templates on these two pages plus the four templates on the following two pages. Either draw round them onto card or stick them onto card. Cut them out. Score and fold along the dotted lines. Join the two main crown pieces together, then add an extra strip of card at the back to make it the right size for your head. Stick the two long pieces at right angles across the top of the crown to make an x shape, then attach the two ball and cross shapes to the centre of the top long piece.














THE IMPERIAL STATE CROWN ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Print and cut out the templates on these two pages plus the four templates on the following two pages. Either draw round them onto card or stick them onto card. Cut them out. Score and fold along the dotted lines. Join the two main crown pieces together, then add an extra strip of card at the back to make it the right size for your head. Stick the two long pieces across the top of the crown at right angles to make an x shape, then attach the two ball and cross shapes to the centre of the top long piece.
