Learning objectives

WHAT: find out about Carlisle Castle's role as a defensive castle on the border; discover the different people who lived in Carlisle Castle and what life was like for each of them.

HOW: through exploration of particular architectural features of the castle, sensory learning and trying on different character costumes.

OUTCOME: students will articulate the importance of Carlisle Castle in the local area; explain what architectural features can tell us about life in a medieval castle; describe some of the people who lived at the castle, what they did and the conditions they lived in.

CAPTAINS, CAPTIVES AND COSTUMES DISCOVERY VISIT

This hands-on guided session takes your class on an exploration of Carlisle Castle. The session uses sensory experiences and costumes to help your students discover who might have lived and worked at the castle in the medieval period and the similarities and differences with our lives today.

PRIOR LEARNING

We recommend you do the following before the Discovery Visit:

- Explore the location of Carlisle Castle on a map.
- Remind students where the medieval period features on a timeline.
- Familiarise students with typical medieval castle features such as a portcullis, drawbridge, murder holes, keep or tower.
