Group Size: The maximum group size for all tours is 25 (minimum usually 11). Groups of more than 25 visitors will be split. We will accommodate a maximum of two groups (50 visitors) within the House at the same time.

Group Booking Standard / Self Guided Visit:

Admission to the House and Grounds is FREE, however we would like to encourage donations and details can be found in the Front Entrance Hall.

English Heritage Kenwood Guided Tours:

Monday – Friday at either 10.30am or 2pm.

Timing: Tours last approx 1 hour. Should you wish to combine tours they would usually take two hours, but can be shortened to fit in with your requirements. Late arrival on pre-booked tours may affect our staffing abilities to deliver the tour.

Prices: Payment or the proof of your payment will be requested in full on the day of your tour.
