









Osborne is a golden-hued, sun-drenched dream of a seaside venue. Inside, stately rooms sparkle with stained glass, chandeliers and treasures from the Royal Collections while the restored 'Osborne yellow' terraces are awash with floral colour, and the well-tended walled garden is bursting with fruits and vegetables. Across the estate the leaves of ancient trees whisper in the breeze, and lush greenlawns roll down to the beach where the Solent gently laps at the shore.

With its versatility, storied past and stunning architecture, Osborne is utterly unique – a venue for weddings that will truly echo through the ages.

Osborne was the cherished island home of Queen Victoria and her beloved Prince Albert.

After meeting for the second time in October 1839 and were engaged five days later.

Albert wrote 'Heaven has sent me an angel whose brightness shall illuminate my life', and it was at Osborne their marriage blossomed into one of the greatest royal love stories of all time.

Victoria commented that Osborne's 'combination of sea, trees, woods, flowers of all kinds, make it, to us, a perfect little paradise'. You and your guests will find that very little has changed.

Osborne has been graced by royal weddings and grand parties for over 160 years and when you celebrate your wedding here, you'll write another chapter in the fascinating story of this magnificent home.



OSBORNE HOUSE

The House

DURBAR ROOM

CEREMONY: 80 | DINING: 74/80

The stunning Durbar Room was built in 1890 as a state banqueting hall. Decorated to celebrate Queen Victoria becoming Empress of India and featured in film Victoria and Abdul, the elaborate banqueting table sits amidst a glittering collection of treasures given to Queen Victoria.



DUCHESS OF KENT SUITE

CEREMONY: 40 | DRINKS: 80 | DINING: 36

Used by George V and Queen Mary for their honeymoon, these lovely interlinked rooms look out over the terraces, ideal for small intimate celebrations, drinks receptions. This room may also be used in conjunction with the Victoria Hall.



VICTORIA HALL

CEREMONY: 120 | DRINKS: 150 | DINING: 100

The Victoria Hall, once Queen Victoria's private chapel, features beautifully arched windows overlooking the garden terraces. Exquisite stained glass decoration in the windows and the beautiful lighting are stunning features of the room. Alongside the Duchess of Kent Suite, the Orangery and the Garden Terraces, it's perfect for your wedding.

The Grounds

BELVEDERE TERRACE

CEREMONY: 50 | DRINKS: 50

The Belvedere Terrace is a beautiful, intimate outside wedding ceremony space with expansive views down Valley Walk to the Solent. Regularly used by Queen Victoria to take breakfast, why not tread in regal footsteps for your ceremony followed by Champagne & canapés on the garden terraces before enjoying a sumptuous wedding breakfast to truly feel like royalty.



WALLED GARDEN

CEREMONY: 100 | DRINKS: 100

One of the only remaining parts of the 18th-century gardens, this space is 3 degrees warmer than any other spot on the estate and was the ideal place for Prince Albert to grow his trees and shrubs alongside flowers for the house. Following on from your ceremony in this sun trap, you and your guests can toast to your future and sip cocktails amid the floral fragrances of trained Victorian fruit trees, roses and parma violets.



LOWER TERRACE

CEREMONY: 250 | DRINKS: 250

The Lower Terraces provide picture-perfect scenery for an open air wedding ceremony or drinks reception. During the summer months, you and your guests will be surrounded by flowers replicating the designs that Queen Victoria and Prince Albert would have walked amongst during their time together at Osborne. What better setting to start your new life?

THE QUEEN'S ALCOVE, PRIVATE BEACH

CEREMONY: 60 Seated (plus 30 standing) | DRINKS: 90

Built in 1869 and decorated in blue Minton tiles, Queen Victoria would often sit in this pretty alcove to sketch or write as she watched as her family enjoyed the sea air. The Queen's Alcove is a unique setting for a wedding ceremony, overlooking the much loved private beach. A marquee reception at the opposite end of the shore would be the perfect accompaniment to this informal and relaxed wedding location.



THE BEACH - MARQUEE

DINING: 150 | DRINKS: 250

With magnificent views across the Solent, it's easy to see why this charming sand and shingle beach was regularly frequented by Queen Victoria and the royal family. Say your vows in the Queen's Alcove before hosting your reception in a marquee for an informal and relaxed wedding location under the stars.

CONDITIONS OF HIRE





As a unique historic building, we have worked closely with our conservation team to ensure we look after Osborne to the very highest standards for future generations. The following conditions have been designed to preserve the building and its contents.

CHILDREN

Children must be kept under adult supervision at all times and the responsibility lies with the parents / guardians whilst on site. A crèche must be provided by the event organiser if there are more than 10 children under 10 present at an event.

CONFETTI

Confetti is not permitted inside the house. Light-coloured undyed rose/flower petal confetti may be thrown outside.

DELIVERIES & COLLECTIONS

It may be possible to arrange for delivery of items the day before your wedding but this must be discussed and agreed with a member of the hospitality events team in advance. Our Hospitality events team will confirm arrival and collection times with your suppliers directly. Your suppliers will need to remove everything the same day.

All other items, including cars, should be collected from Osborne by 10am on the morning following your wedding.

DRINKS

Drinks may be purchased from your caterer or supplied by yourself to your caterer, with no corkage charge. Please contact the hospitality team for further details. Your caterer must be responsible for alcohol service and may charge a service fee. Please note, red wine and port may only be served to seated guests via a waiter service for dinners in the Durbar Room.

BY CAR

Osborne is situated 1 mile south east of the centre of East Cowes on York Avenue, the A3021. For sat nav use postcode PO32 6JT.

PARKING

Please park in the main visitor car park off York Avenue. Disabled parking is available towards the front of the car park, closest to the visitor centre.

BY TRAIN

There is a limited train service on the Island itself - Ryde Esplanade, the closest station to Osborne is 7 miles away. Guests from the mainland can take a train from London to Southampton Central where a dedicated shuttle bus will take them to the Red Funnel Ferry port. The Ferry docks at East Cowes, just 1.3 miles from Osborne.

BY BUS

Osborne is on routes 4 & 5 provided by Southern Vectis. Timetables may be found on www.islandbuses.info.

BY FERRY

The Isle of Wight is accessible by car ferry from Portsmouth, Southampton and Lymington. A fast passenger service is also available. For up to date information visit www.visitisleofwight.co.uk/travel/isle-of-wight-ferry. Discounts on ferry travel are available for you and your guests. Please ask us for more information.

BY HOVERCRAFT

The hovercraft runs from Portsmouth to Ryde.
